The themes of these conferences have varied from year to year, but a constant emphasis is on lifting up women in ministry and providing resources, networking, tools, and skills to enhance their work as ministers.

The Resource Center's program offerings include conferences, workshops, continuing education, mentoring, counseling, and print and media resources.
