




New York Theological Seminary: Certificate in Christian Ministry

The Certificate is a two-year program designed for lay and ordained women and men who are already serving in ministry or are considering a call to ministry. The program is offered in New York and New Jersey in English, and Spanish and French/Creole at some sites; classes meet on Saturdays, week-day evenings, and on-line. Courses are taught by a faculty who are academically qualified and committed to the church. Students who successfully complete the program may receive credits at several colleges and universities in the metropolitan area.
